Landscape

As a reminder, all landscaping within the community—including trees, shrubs, and plantings in common areas and parkways—is maintained by the **Association's contracted landscape service provider**.

To ensure the long-term health and appearance of our community's landscape, we kindly ask that residents refrain from trimming, pruning, or altering any Association-maintained plant material. Unauthorized maintenance can inadvertently damage plants, disrupt their growth patterns, or create safety concerns.

If you notice an area that may require attention, or if you have specific concerns regarding landscaping near your property, please contact the management office. We will be happy to work with our landscaping team to address the issue appropriately.

Tree Maintenance

The BrightView arborist crew will be working in the community during the week of **May 12, 2025**. Their scope of work includes:

- Trimming 33 trees
- Removing 9 trees- these are either unstable, lifting sidewalks, or—specifically in the case of the Drexel trees—shifting the curb.

For details on the specific trees affected, please refer to the attached map.

Looking ahead, the Board plans to review tree replanting plans in 2026, focusing on smaller tree varieties that are better suited to our community's layout, especially along main thoroughfares.

We welcome community feedback and encourage all owners to attend the monthly board meetings to share input and stay informed.
